

16. Assistance in the Organization and Registration of Primary Cooperatives

A cooperative may be organized and registered by at least 25 persons with common bond of interests and are residing or working in the intended area of operation. The primary objective is to provide goods and services to its members and thus, enable them to attain increased income and savings, investment, productivity and to promote among them equitable distribution of net surplus.
