

18. Issuance of Quarantine Clearance.

Covid -19 pandemic, a viral infection, highly communicable, initially by airdrop infection and later documented also by airborne route. It has affected individuals, families and communities in their own household, in public places as well as in the workplaces. Infected individuals may be symptomatic or asymptomatic and severity of illness depends on the patient's health status whether with or without comorbidity and vaccination status. During this COVID-19 pandemic, all individuals with Influenza like illnesses are considered COVID-19 suspects and if tested positive on swab test (RT PCR or RAT), they are diagnosed as confirmed cases.
