

## 2. Immunization Services

The objective of the service is to immunize all children 0-11 months old with the seven (7) immunizable/preventable diseases and catch up for 12-23 months old children if with available vaccines.

Fully immunized children received the seven (7) vaccines (Penta - DPT,Hib,Hepa), OPV, Measles Vaccines) before reaching 1 year old, additional Pneumonia vaccine (PCV 13) for less than one year and MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella Vaccines) at one year old before reaching 2 years old. These vaccines will protect the children from the following diseases:

- ❖ TB
- ❖ Inactivated Polio Vaccine
- ❖ Diphtheria
- ❖ Measles
- ❖ Hepatitis B
- ❖ Pertussis
- ❖ Haemophilus-B Influenzae
- ❖ Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- ❖ Tetanus
- ❖ Pneumonia

The RHU/BHS also provide Tetanus Toxoid immunization to pregnant mothers to prevent Neonatal Tetanus
