

13. Provision of Anti-TB Drugs / Treatment Under DOTS Program PhilHealth Accredited Services Provision of No Balance Billing

This service is given to residents of Tanza who are tuberculosis (TB) suspects or patients for prevention or cure.

TB suspect are any person with the following symptoms:

- ❖ Persistent cough for two weeks
- ❖ On and off fever
- ❖ Progressive weight loss
- ❖ Chest and back pain
- ❖ Haemoptysis/blood streaked sputum
- ❖ Loss of appetite and no weight gain for children
- ❖ Tiredness
- ❖ Contact of a TB case (+) exposure

TB Case: Any person diagnosed by laboratory confirmation or clinical judgement of DOTS attending Physician
