

6. Issuance of Result of Infectious Disease Test Done Through the Municipal Epidemiologic Surveillance Unit (MESU)

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 121-S-2019: AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MUNICIPAL EPIDEMIOLOGY AND SURVEILLANCE UNIT (MESU) AND DIRECTING ALL STAKEHOLDERS TO REPORT ALL NOTIFIABLE DISEASES AND OTHER IMPORTANT HEALTH DATA, NECESSARY IN THE CONDUCTING CONTROL AND ERADICATION MEASURES.

Immediate and weekly notifiable diseases should be reported to MESU, for case investigation and sending specimens (stool, oro and nasopharyngeal swab blood/ serum) for confirmation to DOH accredited testing Facility.

I. Immediately Notifiable Disease/Syndrome, Events and Conditions (Category I):

1. Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP)
2. Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI)
3. Anthrax
4. Human Avian Influenza
5. Measles
6. Meningococcal Disease
7. Neonatal Tetanus
8. Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning
9. Rabies
10. Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome
11. Outbreaks (COVID-19, SARS, MERS COV, other emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases)
12. Clusters of Diseases
13. Unusual Diseases or Threats
